■■ EU Taxonomy

The EC launched consultations with the Member States Expert Group on Sustainable Finance and the Platform on Sustainable Finance on a draft text of a Taxonomy Complementary Delegated Act covering certain nuclear and gas activities. The experts will have to provide their contributions by 12 January. The Commission will then analyse them and formally adopt the act by the end of the month. The text will then be sent to the colegislators for their scrutiny. Once the four months of scrutiny period is over and assuming neither the Council or the European Parliament object, the delegated act will enter into force.
