### ■■ EU Green Deal Investment Plan

The EC presented the European Green Deal Investment Plan, which aims to attract public and private investment over the next decade for the transition to a green, climate-neutral and competitive economy. Together with the communication, the Commission also released the proposal for a regulation establishing the so-called Just Transition Mechanism, that will provide tailored financial and practical support for the regions most affected by the transition. The relevant committees of the European Parliament and the Council will now deal with the Commission proposal; both the Parliament and the Council will have to agree on a final text.

# ■ WTO Agreement on Subsidies and Countervailing Measures

### ■ State Aid in Agriculture, Forestry and Fishery

The EC published a consultation on the draft regulation that prolongs by one year the validity of the existing European State aid rules applicable to agriculture, forestry, fishery and aquaculture sectors, including the block exemption regulations. ### **ETS State Aid Guidelines**

The EC launched a public consultation on the draft revised EU Emission Trading System State Aid Guidelines, in the context of the system for greenhouse gas emission allowance trading post-2021. The draft guidelines aim to shorten the number of sectors eligible for compensation, lower the compensation rate to 75% in the new period, exclude compensation for non-efficient technologies and make compensation conditional upon decarbonisation efforts by the companies concerned. Contributions can be submitted by March 10<sup>th</sup>.

### ■ EU Collective Redress Rules

Representatives of the European Parliament, the Council and the Commission had a first meeting for the negotiations of a new directive on representative actions for the protection of collective interests of consumers, which will repeal Directive 2009/22/EC. Next trilogue will be on March 2<sup>nd</sup>. The European Parliament only agreed on a negotiating position few weeks ago, while the Council approved its text last November, after months of deadlock. The proposed legislation aims at addressing the concerns raised by mass harm scandals with cross-border implications.

The debate among EU Member States on the proposed regulation over the last three years has not been successful; therefore the European Commission will most likely present a new draft of the ePrivacy Regulation in the first quarter of the year.
