■ European Chips Act

The EC presented the so-called European Chips Act package, which consists of a communication, two proposals for a regulation and a recommendation to ensure the EU's security of supply and to bolster Europe's competitiveness and technological leadership in semiconductor technologies and applications. The Commission aims to mobilise more than 43 billion euros of public and private investments and to establish a new framework to prevent and quickly respond to any future supply chain disruption by enhancing production capacities. The package also includes a proposal for a coordination mechanism between Member States and the European Commission for monitoring the supply of semiconductors. The proposals will have to be discussed by the European Parliament and the Council in the ordinary legislative procedure.

■ Carbon Removals

The EC launched a consultation on the rules to monitor, report and verify the authenticity of carbon removals. The aim is to expand sustainable carbon removals and encourage the use of innovative solutions to capture, recycle and store CO₂ by farmers, foresters and industries. Contributions can be submitted until 2 May. The Commission intends to adopt a regulation on a framework for the certification of carbon removals in the fourth quarter of the year.

■ Mercury Regulation

The EC launched a consultation on the review of the Mercury Regulation, in particular on the impacts related to the possible phase-out of dental amalgam and the availability and cost of mercury-free

alternatives. Contributions can be submitted until 3 May.

■ Capital Markets Union

The EC adopted a decision to extend equivalence for UK central counterparties (CCPs) until 30 June 2025 and launched a targeted consultation and a call for evidence on ways to expand central clearing activities in the EU. Contributions can be submitted until 8 March. The Commission intends to release in the second half of the year measures to develop central clearing activities in the EU.

The two countries renewed their commitments to work on common industrial projects, in particular on electrical networks, batteries and hydrogen, through the creation of Franco-German working groups. According to the respective representatives, these groups will serve as an accelerator for efforts made at the European level, in order to strengthen European sovereignty in industrial and ecological topics.

■ Sustainable Products Initiative

The European Commission is planning to present at the end of March its initiative on sustainable products, including a revision of the Ecodesign Directive. The new sustainability rules aim to target a wide range of products, such as electronics, chemicals, textiles.
