Law

Alternative Fuels Infrastructure Regulation

The Transport Committee of the European Parliament voted in favor of the agreement reached last March by negotiators of the European Parliament and the Council on the proposal for a regulation on the mandatory deployment of alternative fuel infrastructure for cars and trucks, which will set minimum mandatory national targets for the deployment of this infrastructure. The agreement now needs to be officially adopted by both the European Parliament in plenary and the Council; then it can be published in the EU Official Journal.

Text of the agreement

Waste Shipments

The Council adopted its position on the proposal to revise the waste shipment regulation. The revised regulation would contain provisions to harmonize and digitalize procedures for shipments within the EU, enhance transport of waste destined for recycling and tackle illegal waste shipments. In particular, the Council agreed to ban waste exports for disposal to another Member State, except under strict conditions and to ban non-hazardous waste shipments to non-OECD countries. Negotiations with the European Parliament on the final shape of the legislation can now start.

Council position

Industrial Emissions

The Environment Committee of the European Parliament adopted its position on the industrial emission directive, which will lay down rules on the prevention and control of pollution from large agro-industrial installations emissions into air, water and soil. Lawmakers backed the Commission's proposal to extend the IED to extractive industry installations, large installations manufacturing batteries and larger-scale cattle farming. Parliament is scheduled to adopt its mandate during the July plenary session, after which negotiations with Council on the final legislation can start. The text will be available soon.

Ukraine

The Council adopted a regulation which renews for another year, until June 2024, the suspension of all customs duties, quotas and trade defense measures on Ukrainian exports to the EU.

Retail Investment Package

The EC presented its Retail Investment Package which aims to improve the way information about investment products and services is provided to retail investors and to increase transparency and comparability of costs. The package contains a series of measures to amend the Markets in Financial Instruments Directive (MiFID II), the Insurance Distribution Directive (IDD), the Undertaking for Collective Investment in Transferable Securities (UCITS) Directive, the Alternative Investment Fund Managers Directive (AIFMD), Solvency II, and the Packaged Retail and Insurance-based Investment Products (PRIIPs) Regulation. The proposals will have to be discussed by both the European Parliament and the Council.

Capital Markets Union

Negotiators of the European Parliament and of the Council reached a political agreement on the proposal for a European Single Access Point (ESAP), which will offer a single access point for public financial and sustainability-related information on EU companies and EU investment products. The text of the agreement will be available soon. This agreement will have to be officially adopted by both the Council and the European Parliament before entering into force.

Instant Payments

The Council agreed its position on the instant payments proposal which aims to improve the availability of instant payment options in euro. Inter-institutional negotiations with the European Parliament in order to agree on a final version of the text can now start.

Council general approach

Ecodesign Regulation

The Council adopted its position on the proposal for a regulation establishing a framework for setting ecodesign requirements for sustainable products, which will replace the 2009 directive. The new rules will set environmental sustainability requirements for almost all categories of products placed on the EU market, which will be displayed in the so-called "Digital Product Passport". The Council position also introduced a direct ban on the destruction of textiles, footwear and apparel. Inter-institutional negotiations with the European Parliament on the final shape of the regulation will start as soon as the Parliament adopts its position.

Council general approach

Machinery Regulation

The Council adopted the new regulation on machinery, which will update the directive of 2006. According to the new rules, third-party conformity assessments for six categories of "high risk" machinery will become mandatory and safety information will have to be provided with every product. The regulation will soon be published in the EU Official Journal and will enter into force on the 20th day following its publication. Businesses and EU Member States will have 42 months to prepare to the new regulation.

The EC shall endorse them within three months of their publication.

The European Securities and Markets Authority (ESMA) launched a consultation on the draft regulatory technical standards under the revised ELTIF Regulation. Contributions can be submitted until 24 August. Also based on the contributions received, ESMA will submit the draft technical standards to the EC for endorsement by 10 January 2024.
