Corporate Sustainability Due Diligence Directive

Negotiators of the European Parliament, the Council and the European Commission reached a provisional agreement on the proposal for a corporate sustainability due diligence directive (CSDDD), which will set obligations for large companies regarding actual and potential adverse impacts on human rights and the environment, with respect to their own operations, those of their subsidiaries and those carried out by their business partners. The provisional deal now needs to be formally adopted by the European Parliament and the Council before it can enter into force.

Artificial Intelligence Act

Negotiators of the European Parliament, the Council and the European Commission reached a provisional agreement on the proposal on harmonized rules on artificial intelligence, so-called Artificial Intelligence Act. The text now needs to be formally adopted by the European Parliament and the Council before entering into force. The agreed text will be available soon.

Critical Raw Materials Act

The European Parliament adopted the agreed text on the proposal for a critical raw materials act, which will establish a framework to ensure EU access to a secure and sustainable supply of critical raw materials. Now the Council needs to formally adopt it before the law can be published in the EU Official Journal.

Liability Rules

Negotiators of the European Parliament, the Council and the European Commission reached a political agreement on a new EU law on liability for defective products. Among other things, under the new rules, the definition of product will be extended to digital manufacturing files and software and the right to compensation will cover both material and non-material losses. The agreement needs to be formally adopted by the European Parliament and the Council. The agreed text will be available soon.

The EC published the template for reporting on consumer profiling techniques and the independent audit of such reports.

State Aid

The EC adopted two regulations amending the general rules for small amounts of aid, de minimis Regulation, and for small amounts of aid for Services of General Economic interest, SGEI de minimis Regulation. The revised regulations will enter into force on 1 January 2024 and will apply until 31 December



2030.

Russia Sanctions

The EC submitted to EU Member States its proposal to establish a regulatory framework for identifying and confiscating the profits generated by the assets of the Central Bank of Russia. EU Member States must unanimously agree the measure. The text of the proposal is not public.

The European Commission together with the High Representative submitted to the Council a proposal for the 12th package of sanctions. The package contains over 120 additional individuals and entities; new import and export bans and measures to counter circumvention of sanctions. The proposal now needs to be agreed by all Member States.

Definition of Criminal Offences

Negotiators of the European Parliament and the Council reached a provisional political agreement on the proposal to harmonize criminal offences and penalties for the violation of EU restrictive measures. The agreement now needs to be formally adopted by the European Parliament and the Council. The agreed text will be available soon.

Asset Recovery and Confiscation

Negotiators of the European Parliament and the Council reached a political agreement on the proposal for a directive on asset recovery and confiscation, which will set out EU-wide minimum rules on the tracing, identification, freezing, confiscation and management of criminal property. The proposed rules will also apply to the violation of sanctions once a pending directive on the definition of criminal offences and penalties for the violation of EU restrictive measures has been adopted. The agreed text now needs to be formally adopted by the European Parliament and the Council. The text of the agreement will be available soon.

Anti-money Laundering

Negotiators of the Council and the European Parliament reached a provisional agreement on the proposal to create a new European authority for countering money laundering and financing of terrorism. The authority will also monitor that selected obliged entities have internal policies and procedures in place to ensure the implementation of targeted financial sanctions asset freezes and confiscations. The text now needs to be adopted by the European Parliament and the Council. The agreed text will be available soon. Negotiations on the regulation on anti-money-laundering requirements for the private sector and the directive on anti-money laundering mechanisms are still ongoing.

Insurance Sector

Negotiators of the Council and the European Parliament reached a provisional agreement on amendments to the Solvency II directive. The texts of the provisional agreements now need to be finalized and adopted by the European Parliament and the Council. The agreed texts will be available soon.

Construction Products

Negotiators of the Council, the European Parliament and the European Commission reached an agreement on the proposal for a regulation updating the rules on sustainability for construction products and their standardization on the single market. The European Commission will be empowered to establish mandatory minimum environmental sustainability requirements via delegated acts for public procurement of construction products. The deal now needs to be formally adopted by the European Parliament and the Council. The agreed text will be available soon.

Energy Performance of Buildings

Negotiators of the European Parliament, the Council and the European Commission reached a provisional political agreement on a proposal to revise the energy performance of buildings directive. The provisional agreement now needs to be endorsed and formally adopted by the European Parliament and the Council. The agreed text will be available soon.

Electricity Market Design

Negotiators of the European Parliament, the Council and the European Commission reached a provisional agreement to reform the EU's electricity market design (EMD). The provisional agreement now needs to be endorsed and formally adopted by the European Parliament and the Council. The agreed text will be available soon.

Gas Package

Negotiators of the European Parliament, the Council and the European Commission reached a provisional political agreement on a regulation that establishes common internal market rules for renewable and natural gases and hydrogen. The provisional agreement now needs to be formally adopted by the European Parliament and the Council. The agreed text will be available soon.

EU-Chile Agreement

The EU and Chile signed an Advanced Framework Agreement and an Interim Trade Agreement to strengthen political cooperation and foster trade and investment. The new agreements will now be submitted to the European Parliament for its scrutiny.

EU-Kenya Agreement

The Council adopted a decision on the signing of the EU-Kenya Economic Partnership Agreement, which will provide duty-free, quota-free EU market access to all exports from Kenya in addition to a partial and gradual opening of the Kenyan market to imports from the EU. Now the European Parliament needs to give its consent and the agreement needs to be signed in order for the deal to enter into force.


