■ Online Economy

The independent expert group of the Observatory on the Online Platform Economy published three draft progress reports, which cover the major aspects of data access, differentiated treatment and other key aspects of the online platform economy. Interested parties can submit their feedback by 8 September. These documents will inform the work of the Commission on online platforms and in particular on the Digital Services Act package. The final report by the expert group shall be adopted by the end of the year.

■ Energy System Integration

The EC adopted its strategies for energy system integration which will provide the framework for the green energy transition, setting out 38 actions to

create a more integrated system. These include the revision of existing legislation, financial support, deployment of new technologies, guidance on fiscal measures and phasing out of fossil fuels subsidies. Among the foreseen proposals there is the revision of the TEN-E regulation by the end of 2020 and of the energy taxation directive and the gas market regulatory framework in 2021.

Together with the energy system integration strategy, the Commission released its hydrogen action plan. To help transform this potential into reality, the Commission launched the European Clean Hydrogen Alliance with all the interested parties.

Competition

The EC published the Report on Competition Policy, which contains the most important legislative initiatives and key decisions adopted last year.

■ Collective Redress

The Legal Affairs Committee of the European Parliament adopted the agreement reached between the negotiators on the proposal for a directive on representative actions for the protection of collective interests of consumers, which will introduce a harmonised model for collective redress in all Member States. The plenary is expected to vote on it in the autumn. Once the whole Parliament and Council have formally approved the agreement, Member States will have two years to transpose the directive into national law.

■ Brexit

The EC adopted a sector-by-sector overview of the main areas where there will be changes at the end of the transition period (31 December), regardless of the outcome of the ongoing negotiations. The Commission is also reviewing the stakeholder notices already published.

Capital Markets Union

The EC launched a consultation on the Capital Markets Union Action Plan, which aims at supporting the creation of a pan-European capital markets architecture. Contributions can be submitted until 4 August.

■ Rapid Alert System

The EC published its latest report on the system to prevent or restrict the selling of dangerous products on the market, the so-called Rapid Alert System; and the results of the Coordinated Activities on the Safety of Products (CASP).
