■ Intellectual Property – Standard essential Patents

The EC published a call for evidence and a public consultation on standard-essential patents (SEPs), with the aim to improve the current system. In particular, the Commission intends to improve the enforcement of SEPs and to give guidance on the concept of fair, reasonable and non-discriminatory terms and conditions, with a possible new SEP licensing framework or antitrust guidance. Contributions can be submitted until 9 May.

■ European Defence

The EC released its initiatives in the areas of defence and security, in order to strengthen the competitiveness of the European defence market. More precisely, the Commission intends to stimulate

investments and incentivise the joint procurement of defence capabilities within the Union. It also invites Member States to gradually converge their arms export control practices, in particular for military equipment and technology developed in cooperation. The Commission also presented a roadmap on critical technologies for security and defence. Based on the data of the Observatory of critical technologies, the EC will present to Member States a classified report on critical technologies and risks associated with strategic dependencies affecting security, space and defence by the end of the year.

■ Hazardous Substances in Electronics

The EC launched a consultation on the review of the restriction of the use of hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment, with the aim to

increase the efficiency of the current rules and improve their enforcement. Contributions can be submitted until 14 March. The adoption is planned for the fourth quarter of the year.

■ Anti-dumping

Commission Implementing Regulation of 16 February 2022 imposing a definitive anti-dumping duty on imports of certain iron or steel fasteners originating in the People's Republic of China has been published in the EU Official Journal.

■ WTO

The EU filed a case against China at the World Trade Organisation for restricting European companies from going to a foreign court to protect and use their patents. In 60 days the EU can request the WTO to set up a panel if the dispute settlement consultations not lead to a satisfactory solution.

■ ■ Battery Regulation

The Environment Committee of the European Parliament voted on the amendments to the proposed regulation concerning batteries and waste batteries. The lawmakers generally agreed on the Commission's proposal but they push for higher targets: 70% portable battery collection by 2025 compared to the Commission's original proposal of 65% and 80% by 2030 instead of 70%. The proposal will have to be adopted by the Parliament and the Council.

■ Corporate Sustainability Reporting

At the Competitiveness Council meeting of 24 February European Ministers will discuss the proposal for a directive on corporate sustainability reporting (CSRD). They are expected to agree on a general approach on the proposal. The CSRD proposal requires companies to publish detailed information on sustainability matters and extends existing rules on non-financial reporting.

■ Foreign Subsidies

European Ministers responsible for the internal market and industry will discuss at the Council meeting of 24 February the proposal for a regulation on foreign subsidies distorting the internal market.
