The EC adopted the first update since its adoption in 1997 of the Communication on the definition of the relevant market for the purposes of EU competition law.

Artificial Intelligence Act

Member States' ambassadors at the Council (Coreper) unanimously endorsed the provisional political agreement on the Artificial Intelligence Act, which was reached by the negotiators of the Council, the European Parliament and the European Commission on 8 December 2023. The responsible Committee at the European Parliament is expected to adopt the text on 13 February, followed by a plenary vote scheduled for April. Final step is the formal adoption by the Council. Then the AI Act can be published in the EU Official Journal, and it will enter into force 20 days after that. The agreed text will be available soon.

Sustainability Reporting Directive

Negotiators of the European Parliament, the Council and the European Commission reached a provisional agreement on the proposal for a directive on the time limits for the adoption of sustainability reporting standards for certain sectors and for certain third-country undertakings amending the Corporate Sustainability Reporting Directive (CSRD). The provisional agreement now needs to be formally adopted by the two co-legislators, the European Parliament and the Council, before entering into force. The agreed text will be available soon.

ESG Ratings

Negotiators of the Council, the European Parliament and the Commission reached a provisional agreement on the proposal for a regulation on environmental, social and governance (ESG) rating activities, which aims to strengthen the reliability and comparability of ESG ratings by improving the transparency and integrity of the operations of ESG ratings providers. The agreement needs to be formally adopted by both the European Parliament and the Council. The agreed text will be available soon.

Digital Services Act

The EC launched a public consultation on its draft guidelines on the integrity of electoral processes. Contributions can be submitted until 7 March.

Net-Zero Industry Act

Negotiators of the European Parliament, the Council and the European Commission reached a provisional agreement on the regulation establishing a framework of measures for strengthening Europe's net-zero technology products manufacturing ecosystem, the so-called Net-Zero Industry Act. The provisional agreement now needs to be endorsed and formally adopted by the European Parliament and the Council.

Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment

The European Parliament approved the provisional agreement reached with the Council on the proposal to review Directive 2012/19/EU on the management of waste electrical and electronic equipment. Next step is the formal adoption by the Council.

Industrial Carbon Management

The EC published a list of actions to be taken both at European and national level to enable the deployment of technologies that can capture CO2 or remove it directly from the atmosphere and then store or utilize it.

EC Communication

Climate Targets

The EC released a communication with its climate targets for 2040 and a roadmap for the next stage of its energy transition. In particular, the Commission recommends a 90% net greenhouse gas emissions reduction by 2040 compared to 1990 levels. It will be the next Commission, after the European elections, that will work on legislative proposals for the post-2030 framework. At the same time, a dedicated taskforce will be set up with the goal to develop a global approach to carbon pricing and carbon markets.

Gigabit Infrastructure Act

Negotiators of the European Parliament, the Council and the European Commission reached a provisional agreement on the proposed regulation that will replace the 2014 broadband cost-reducing directive (BCRD). The provisional agreement now needs to be formally adopted by the two co-legislators, the European Parliament and the Council before entering into force. The agreed text will be available soon.

The EC adopted new rules which will review the Delegated Regulation 305/2013 on the specification of emergency calls centers receiving and handling eCalls to 4G/5G telecommunications networks by onboard vehicle systems.

Capital Markets Union

Negotiators of the Council, the European Parliament and the European Commission reached a provisional agreement on the proposal to review the European market infrastructure regulation and directive, which aims to make the EU clearing landscape more attractive and resilient. The provisional agreement now needs to be formally adopted. The text will be available soon.



Toxic Mercury

Negotiators of the European Parliament, the Council and the European Commission reached a provisional political agreement on the proposal for a revision of the Mercury Regulation, which aims to prohibit the last intentional remaining uses of mercury in the Union. The European Parliament and the Council will now have to formally adopt the regulation before it can enter into force. The agreed text will be available soon.

The European Commission is preparing the upcoming evaluation of the European rules regarding the information on the fuel consumption and CO2 emissions of new cars sold or leased in the EU. The revised rules shall be adopted on the fourth quarter of the year.

Product Safety

The European Commission is preparing its guidelines for producers and distributors to notify dangerous products, which will repeal Decision 2004/905/EC. Adoption is planned for third quarter of the year.
