Euro 7

The European Parliament endorsed the agreement reached with the Council last December on the final shape of the proposed regulation on type-approval and market surveillance of motor vehicles, the so-called Euro 7 regulation. Now the Council needs to formally approve the text before it can be published in the EU Official Journal and enter into force.

The EC formally sent requests for information under the Digital Services Act to Bing, Google Search, Facebook, Instagram, Snapchat, TikTok, YouTube and X on their respective mitigation measures for risks linked to generative AI.

Cyber Resilience Standards

The European Parliament endorsed the agreement reached with the Council on the regulation on new cyber resilience standards, which aims to ensure that products with digital features are secure to use, resilient against cyber threats and provide enough information about their security properties. The text now needs to be formally adopted by the Council to come into law.

Green Claims Directive

The European Parliament adopted its report on the proposal for a directive which would set detailed rules on substantiating and communicating explicit environmental claims about products, in business-to-consumer commercial practices, so-called green claims directive. Inter-institutional negotiations with the Council on the final shape of the law will soon start.

The European Parliament adopted its report on the proposal to review the Waste Framework Directive, with extended producer responsibility schemes. Inter-institutional negotiations with the Council on the final shape of the law will start soon.

Industrial Emissions

The European Parliament voted in favour of the provisional political agreement reached with the Council on the revision of the industrial emission directive, which will make it mandatory to set emissions levels for the sectors covered. The revised directive will also cover extractive industry installations and large installations manufacturing batteries. The text now needs to be adopted by the Council before being published in the EU Official Journal.

Energy Performance of Buildings

The European Parliament adopted the text agreed with the Council on the proposed revision of the Energy Performance of Buildings Directive, which aims to progressively reduce greenhouse gas emissions and energy consumption in the EU building sector and make it climate neutral by 2050. The directive now needs to be formally adopted by the Council and published in the EU Official Journal to become law.

EU sanctions

The European Parliament voted in favour of the political agreement reached with the Council on the proposal to harmonise criminal offences and penalties for violating EU sanctions, such as arms embargoes, import and export bans on certain products, freezing of funds and economic resources. The new law will introduce a common definition of, and minimum penalties for, violations. The text now needs to be formally adopted by the Council before it can be published in the EU Official Journal. EU Member States will have one year to transpose it into national legislation.

The Parliament also voted in favour of the provisional agreement on the directive covering freezing and confiscation of criminal money, which will modernize the legal framework. The text will have to be officially adopted by the Council before being published in the EU Official Journal.

The European Parliament adopted its position on the proposal for a regulation establishing the Union Customs Code and the EU Customs Authority. Inter-institutional negotiations with the Council on the final shape of the law will soon start.

The European Parliament adopted its position on the proposal for a regulation on compulsory licensing for crisis management, which will amend the current framework. Inter-institutional negotiations with the Council on the final shape of the law will soon start.

EU Design Package

The European Parliament voted in favour of the political agreement reached with the Council on the EU design package, which is composed of the proposal for a regulation on Community designs and the proposal for a directive on the legal protection of designs. The two texts now needs to be officially adopted by the Council before being published in the EU Official Journal.

Company Law

Negotiators of the European Parliament, the Council and the European Commission reached a provisional agreement on the directive which will expand and upgrade the use of digital tools and processes in company law. The text now needs to be formally adopted by the European Parliament and the Council. The agreement will be available soon.

Platform Workers

The Council confirmed the provisional agreement reached with the European Parliament on the digital platform workers directive, which aims to improve working conditions and regulate the use of algorithms by digital labour platforms. The text now needs to be finalized in all the EU official languages before being formally adopted by both the European Parliament in plenary and the Council.

Liability Defective Products

The European Parliament endorsed the text agreed with the Council on the proposal for a directive on liability for defective products. The deal now needs to be officially adopted by the Council before it can enter into force.

The European Parliament adopted its report on the proposal to revise EU toy safety legislation. Interinstitutional negotiations with the Council on the final shape of the law will soon start.
